



Oregon Registry Data Report as of June 30, 2009

The **Oregon Registry: Pathways for Professional Recognition in Childhood Care and Education** is a voluntary, statewide program to document and recognize the professional achievements of people who work in the childhood care and education profession.

The Oregon Registry Steps show the sequence from Enrollment through Step 12 within the Oregon Registry. Each step represents increased training and education in the Oregon Core Body of Knowledge for the Childhood Care and Education Profession.

As of June 30, 2009 there was a total of 14,434 non-duplicated Oregon Registry awarded Steps (Table 1). This includes 1,820 at "Enrollment", those who have filled out the Enrollment Form only. Step 1 has 6,771 and Step 2 has 4,325 awarded steps. The numbers of participants are higher at Steps 1 and 2 because they mostly include Enhanced Rate Eligible family child care providers.

These figures show an increase of Oregon Registry Steps since end of December 2008 by 997. It is projected that with the introduction of Education Awards incentives program in May 2009, the number of Oregon Registry Steps awarded will dramatically increase in the next fiscal year, since the number of Oregon Registry applications jumped in the end of the 4th quarter following the announcement of the Education Awards. To make a comparison, following are the numbers of applications by quarter in fiscal year 2008-2009: Q1 = 84; Q2 = 80; Q3 = 102; Q4 = 550.

Table 1 indicates steps awarded by county. The "N/A" (not applicable) designation for county is used when there is no current address, and mail is undeliverable. Numbers in border state counties are reported, since there are Oregon Registry participants residing in Washington and California who may be working in Oregon.

Of the 14,434 total, there are currently 7,529 active and 6,905 inactive Oregon Registry awarded Steps (Table 2). Once awarded, an Oregon Registry step belongs to the individual indefinitely. To continue to be listed as "active", however, participants must complete and return an update every two years that reviews, affirms and/or updates currency of information, such as address, phone numbers, and work-related information. Should this update not be returned, the participant is listed as "inactive". There is always the option to complete an update and to move back from inactive to active status.

To see the comparison of Steps 3 – 12 awarded to family child care providers by county to the number of registered and certified family child care providers, see Table 3. As the table shows, 9% of licensed family child care has a Step 3 or higher. All newly registered family child care providers have at least a Step 1 and renewing providers have at least a Step 2.

Oregon Registry participants can document further training and education and increase their step designations. OCCD is currently developing a table or chart which will clearly show step increases within a six month period.
